R. 59 E which lands covers the course of Creek running from Beck Spring and in building fences made ample provision for Wilson Bros stock to water. Request that your office in granting final permit papers to Vincent Matteucci insert clause or provision that ~~the~~ our stock may at all times have free access to the waters of Beck Spring. Mr Matteucci's Homestead Entry was filed on by him about 1913 AD.
