PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES

From STING BOTTLE SPRING Name of natural water course

Through channel of flow from spring Name of ditch, pipe line, etc.

the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by The Adams-McGill Company are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

(1) Name of claimant The Adams-McGill Company Address Ely, County of White Pine State of Nevada

(2) The means of diversion employed is now by iron pipe and water troughs Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in 150 galvanized iron water troughs Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun on original plan in 1903 and completed in 1905

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is owned through purchase by the Company

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of County, at Page of Book of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 2500 and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 8 months days during each of the following months April 1st to November 30th

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

approximately 2,500 sheep have been watered at this spring each year since 1903. The Company has long used this spring as a watering place at time of lambing.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been

$\frac{1}{40}$  cubic feet per second.

40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at  $N31^{\circ}05'E, 4450$  feet from the SW corner of Section 35, T. 12N, R. 65E, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at SE 1/4 of NW 1/4, Sec 35, T 12N, R 65E, M. D. M.  
Describe as within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: in the original use of the water, the channel of the flow from Sting Nettle spring was widened and dams were used to impound the water for the stock. In later years, improvements have been made in the care of this water and we now carry the water from the spring through an iron pipe and into 150 feet of galvanized iron troughs 20 inches in diameter. It is unusual for the water to flow off from land mentioned and owned by our Company.
