(2) The means of diversion employed is channel dams and ditch at beginning
Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in small reservoirs at beginning
Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun in 1900 and completed in 1900

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is owned by The Adams-McGill Company through purchase

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of County, at Page of Book of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 2,500, and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 8 months days during each of the following months April 1st to November 30th

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

the waters of this spring have been used every year since 1900 by The Adams-McGill Company for watering sheep, about 2,500; this spring is on the range used each year as a lambing ground by the Company.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been

$\frac{1}{40}$ cubic feet per second.

40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at S 60° 40' W 3,790 feet from

True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance

the NE corner of Section 17, T. 12N., R. 65 E.,
Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at NE 1/4 of SE 1/4, Sec 17, T 12N., R 65E., M. D. M.

Describe as within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: the channel of the flow from the spring was widened and dams put in to form small pools for use in watering sheep; it was later deemed advisable to put in troughs, and the water is now conveyed through an iron pipe to 150 feet of galvanized iron troughs 20 inches in diameter.
