the waters of this spring have been used each subsequent year by The Adams-McGill Company for watering approximately 2,500 sheep; this spring is on the range used each year by The Adams-McGill Company as a lambing ground.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been

1/40 cubic feet per second.

40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at S 12° E, 7680 feet from

True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance

the NW corner of Section 16, T. 12N, R. 65E, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

(11) The works are located at SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec 21, T. 12N, R. 65E, M. D. M.

Remarks: the channel of the flow of this spring has been widened and dams put in to form small pools for use in watering sheep; these are kept up each year. The water of this spring seldom flows off this land owned by the Company. This is a method of impounding water which is sometimes used where the water does not sink too rapidly.
