(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 2,500, and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 8 months days during each of the following months April 1st to November 30th

The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

the waters of this spring have been used every year since 1903 by the Adams-McGill Company for watering about 2,500 sheep; this spring is on the range used each year as a lambing ground by the Company.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been $\frac{1}{40}$ cubic feet per second.

40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at S 86°, 40' E, 980 feet from the NW corner of Section 16, T. 12N, R. 65E, E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec 16, T. 12N, R. 65E, M. D. M.

Remarks: the channel of the flow from the spring has been widened and small dams put across the stream that small pools may form, making drinking places for the sheep; these have been kept up from year to year. It is unusual for the flow to be enough to carry off from land owned by the Company.
