duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by  
him are full and correct to the best of his  
knowledge and belief.

(2) The means of diversion employed dam and ditch

(3) The date of the survey of ditch, canal, or pipe line was March 20, 1860

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun 1860  
and completed 1861

(5) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as originally constructed were: Width on bottom 20  
feet, width on top 22 feet, depth 4 feet, on a grade of 1/4 feet per thousand feet.

(6) The conduit was (has not) been enlarged.

(7) The work of enlargement of the ditch or canal was begun  
and completed

(8) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as enlarged are: Width on bottom feet, width on

(11) Crops of alfalfa, wild and native grass hay, timothy, red top,  
vegetables, fruits and other agricultural and horticultural products  
have been grown upon the land irrigated.

(12) The water has been used for irrigation from March 1st to November 1st  
of each year.

(13) The water was first used for irrigation by claimant or his grantors in the year 1862  
when 35 acres were irrigated in the W 1/2 NE 1/4, W 1/2 SE 1/4 of Sec. 22,  
T. 15. N., R. 20 E., M.D.R. & M. The right being claimed as of  
priority of 1860 for said 35 acres.



(19) The map provided by the State Engineer and attached hereto as a part of this proof is hereby accepted as correctly showing the ditches or irrigation works diverting or conveying the water claimed and the lands irrigated.

(20) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: stockwatering and domestic purposes.

(21) The character of the soil is sandy and gravelly. The soil needs 5 to 6 acre-feet per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of one cubic foot of water per second, during the irrigation season of 6 or 7 months, is needed to irrigate each 60 acres of land.

(22) Remarks: See the proof of Mexican Dam and Ditch Company, under which claimant obtained his rights, for further description concerning the original appropriation which proof is referred to and made a part hereof.
