✓ Commencing at a point on the southerly side of Minnie street 247 feet westerly from the southwesterly corner of Minnie Street and alley, which corner is 637 ft and 9 in west of the SE corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 33, Twp 13 N.R. 20 E. the place of beginning, running at right angle to Minnie Street in southwesterly direction, along the northwesterly side of Rodenbah lot 167 feet; thence in a westerly direction along line of Slough, seventy-nine feet, thence in a northesaterly direction along the southeasterly sies of Heitman lot 225 feet to Minnie Street; thence in a southeasterly direction along the Southerly side of Minnie street 70 feet to the place of beginning.
