Bence, C.E. in April 1895, being a certain tract of land conveyed by H.C. Jepsen and wife to P.C. Wilder by deed dated Oct. 27, 1893. Together with water right out of ditch located along the western boundaries of the above described premises for irrigating the same and domestic use. Also water right out of tank for domestic use, said tank being situate on property of Walter Frey.
