(19) The map provided by the State Engineer and attached hereto as a part of this proof is hereby accepted as correctly showing the ditch lines or irrigation works diverting or conveying the water claimed and the lands irrigated.

(20) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: domestic and stock watering

(21) The character of the soil is sandy The soil needs acre-feet per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.

(22) Remarks: This land was held by various owners since the building of the Ezell- McFanning ditch and was cultivated with the other lands in that section. At the time of the Chandler Findings the land had been sold for a town lot and evidently the then owner neglected to claim the water right appurtenant thereto, although constantly using the water without complaint from any source and by all presumed to have a title from the Chandler findings.

The land is described as follows, to-wit:
"beginning at a point 79.6 feet south-westerly from the southeast corner of the Douglas County Farmers Bank building and in the center line of the Jepsen ditch running thence 33.0 feet to the South east corner of the Herman Lampe lot; thence northwesterly along Lampe's south line 30 feet to C.M. Krummes East line; thence southwesterly along said Krummes lot 155 feet; thence south easterly 57.1 feet; thence northeasterly 140.0 feet to point of beginning, with all the improvements thereon, and all water and water rights, ditch and ditch rights belonging thereto.
