The character of the soil is sandy and gravelly. The soil needs 5 to 6 acre-feet per annum to properly irrigate the crops.

A continuous flow of one cubic foot of water per second, during the irrigation season of 6 or 7 months, is needed to irrigate each 60 acres of land.

The claim for the full amount of land lying under the Mexican Ditch is made and claimed under priority of original date of construction of Mexican Ditch, to-wit, 1860, for the reason that it is a part of the original proposal and ultimately carried into effect.
