(19) The map provided by the State Engineer and attached hereto as a part of this proof is hereby accepted as correctly showing the ditch lines or irrigation works diverting or conveying the water claimed and the lands irrigated.

(20) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: Domestic purposes

(21) The character of the soil is loam (Sandy, gravelly, loam) The soil needs various acre-feet per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of 93 inches ~~at least~~ of water per second, during the irrigation season of 8 months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.

(22) Remarks: the full 280 inches of water is diverted at diversion point No.1 after May first. Diversion point No.2 is used to divert water prior to May first, during high water season. That is to say, water is diverted from diversion No.1 and No.2 prior to May first of each year, and after May first diverted only from diversion point No.1.
