(10) The water is diverted from its source at N. 83° 16' W 16,273 feet from the Southeast corner of Section 33, T. 19 N., R. 39 E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

(11) The works are located at The same point described under (10) approximately the NW. 1/4 S.W. 1/4 Sec. 31, T. 19 N., R. 39 E., MDM. (Unsurveyed)

The works at this spring consist of a feet of 1 1/4" pipe leading from the spring to two galv iron tanks each 3' diam. by 16" deep.

Prior to this installation the works consisted of two earthen reservoirs at the spring 8' and 12' in diam. respectively.


