are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

(20) Remarks: (Under question 7) The ditch has not actually been enlarged except by cleaning out and piling debris on the banks. This process has enlarged the ditch to about 2 1/2' on bottom, 3 1/2' on top and 3' deep at the present time.

Water is taken out of Six Mile Canyon in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 27, T. 17 N., R. 21 E., and conveyed through 325' of ditch 150' of 8" flume which crosses to the north side of Six Mile Canyon thence through 500' of ditch and thence returns to natural channel in the west part of the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 27, T. 17 N., R. 21 E. At the end of the 500' ditch and just before water is returned to stream it is used through five cyanide tanks for reduction and milling of gold and silver ore.
