


THE STATE OF NEVADA
 PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR IRRIGATION



From Lehman Creek
Name of natural water source

Through Lehman Ditch
Name of ditch, flume, or pipe line

C. T. Rhodes, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by A. S. Lehman are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(1) Name of claimant C. T. Rhodes
 Address Baker, County of White Pine
 State of Nevada

(2) The means of diversion employed Rock dam and ditch
Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The date of the survey of ditch, canal, or pipe line was Prior to 1905

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun About 1887
 and completed About 1887

(5) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as originally constructed were: Width on bottom very steep
 feet, width on top 1 1/2 feet, depth 1 ft. feet, on a grade of - feet per thousand feet.

(6) The conduit has ~~has not~~ been enlarged by natural erosion in cleaning ditch.
NOTE—If enlargement or extension of ditch was made, supply information under (7) and (8)

(7) The work of enlargement of the ditch or canal was begun and completed

(8) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as enlarged are: Width on bottom 2 feet, width on top 3 feet, depth 1 feet, on a grade of - feet per thousand feet.

(9) The claimant is ~~(is not)~~ an owner in the above-described conduit.

If claimant is an owner in the conduit, state interest held on this line

(10) The nature of the title to the land for which the water right is claimed is By squatter's right until Dec. 13, 1919, when Homestead Patent #724063 was issued to Ernest C. Adams, successor to A. S. Lehman.

(11) Crops of Hay, grain and vegetables and fruit have been grown upon the land irrigated.

(12) The water has been used for irrigation from April 15th to Oct. 15th of each year.

(13) The water was first used for irrigation by claimant's 6 grantors in the year 1887 when 14.0 acres were irrigated in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 10 T. 13 N., R. 69 E., and the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 15, T. 13 N., R. 69 E.

(19) The map provided by the State Engineer and attached hereto as a part of this proof is hereby accepted as correctly showing the ditch lines or irrigation works diverting or conveying the water claimed and the lands irrigated.

(20) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: Stockwatering and domestic

(21) The character of the soil is Sandy gravel (Sandy, gravelly, loam). The soil needs 4 acre-feet per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of 1½ cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of 6 months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.

(22) Remarks: This right was initiated by A. S. Lehman in about 1887 and used by him until it was sold to Philip M. Baker who in turn disposed of it to Ernest C. Adams. Adams made a homestead entry and acquired title to the land by virtue of patent from the U. S. government. Adams sold to Nathan Kiger and C. T. Rhodes on November 6, 1920. Patent is recorded in Book 82, pages 168-169, records of White Pine County.
