

300 head of cattle from 1892 to date, 2500 sheep have ranged in the vicinity of and used the water from this creek and some other springs during May, June, July, August and September of each year since 1898.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been

(10) The water is diverted from its source at point S 21° 10' W 1070 ft to feet from

the South 1/4 corner of Section 15, T. 11, R. 63 E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.
