J. H. Eager, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by The Adams-McGill Company Inc. are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

As General Manager of the Adams-McGill Company Inc. If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(1) Name of claimant The Adams-McGill Company Inc. Address P. O. Box 518 Ely, County of White Pine County, State of Nevada

(2) The means of diversion employed is ditches and pipe lines Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in 150 feet of 20" steel trough Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun used in open ditch prior to 1914, and completed Troughs were put in in 1914

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is Land bought from the State of Nevada

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Was not recorded County, at Page of Book of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 150, and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of Thirty days during each of the following months, July, August, and September

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

150 cattle from prior 1892 to date. 2500 sheep ranging in vicinity, using Jones and other springs during May, June, July, August and September, continuously since 1898.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been

1/4 cu feet per second cubic feet per second.
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at a point S 15° 45', East 3700 ft. feet from
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance

the S 1/4 corner of Section 35, T. 12, R. 63 E.,
Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at S.E. 1/4 of N.W. 1/4 sec. 35, T 12, R 63E.
Describe as within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: Water from Jones Spring were used by J. W. Adams for watering range cattle from some time prior to 1892 to 1898 and by The Adams-McGill Co for sheep and cattle from 1898 to date.
