(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 250 head and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of thirty days during each of the following months May, June, July Aug and September

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:
250 or more head of cattle from 1892 to present date, and from 1898 to present
date 2500 sheep ranging in vicinity and using waters from Bull Whack and other
springs during May, June July, August and September of each year

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been
 $\frac{1}{4}$ cu foot per second cubic feet per second.

40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at a point ^{See map.} $S 62^{\circ} 45'$ W 2500 ft feet from
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance
the West $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 2, T. 11, R. 63 E.,
Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.
