(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

250 cattle from 1892 to date, from 1898 to date 2500 sheep in vicinity using South Bull Whack Springs and others during the months of May, June, July, August and September

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been

1/4 cu foot per second cubic feet per second.
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at a point S 70° 30' E 860 ft feet from the S.E. corner of Section 3, T. 11, R. 63 E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at In S.E. of S.E. Sec. 3- T 11 Range 63E
Describe as within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: The waters from South Bull Whack Springs was used by J. W. Adams for watering cattle from some time prior to 1892 to 1898, and from 1898 to date by The Adams-McGill Company, for about 2500 sheep and 250 head of cattle.
