J. H. Eger, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by The Adams-McGill Company are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

(2) The means of diversion employed is Ditches and pipe lines Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in 150 feet of 20" steel trough Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun used in open ditch prior to 1899, wooden and completed troughs put in about 1900 replaced by steel troughs in 1910

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is Land bought from State of Nevada

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of was not recorded County, at Page of Book of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 250 to 500 head and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of thirty days during each of the following months May, June, July, August and September

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

250 or more head of cattle from prior to 1892 to date and from 1898 to date 2500
sheep ranging in vicinity, using Chimney Rock Springs and others during the months
of May, June, July, August and September

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been

1/4 cu feet per second cubic feet per second.
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at a point N 71° 25', W 1930 ft. feet from
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance
the N. W. corner of Section 10, T. 11, R. 63 E.,
Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at in N. E. of N.W 1/4 Sec. 10, T 11, R 63E
