(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 100 cattle and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of thirty days during each of the following months May, June, July, August and September

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:  
100 cattle from 1892 to date and 2500 sheep ranging in vicinity and using waters  
of Blind and other springs from 1898 to date during the months of May, June, July,  
August and September of each year.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been  
1/20..... cubic feet per second.

40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at a point S 82° 30', E 3040 feet ~~to~~ to  
the S.E. corner of Section 10, T. 11N, R. 63 E.,  
Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at in S.E. 1/4 of S.W. 1/4, Sec. 10, T. 11N, R. 63E. M.D.B.M.  
Describe as within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

range cattle from prior to 1892 to 1898 and by The Adams-McGill Company Inc.  
for bothe sheep and cattle from 1898 to date.
