J. H. Eager, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by The Adams-McGill Company Inc. are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

As General Manager for The Adams-McGill Company Inc. If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(1) Name of claimant The Adams-McGill Company Inc. Address P. O. Box 518 Ely, County of White Pine, State of Nevada

(2) The means of diversion employed is Dam and pipe lines Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in 100 feet 20" iron troughs and 60 feet of 12" wooden troughs Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun wooden troughs put in prior to 1902 and completed steel troughs put in in 1912

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is Bought from the State of Nevada.

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Not recorded County, at Page of Book of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 150 cattle and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of thirty days during each of the following months May, June, July, August and September

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:  
150 cattle from some time prior to 1892 to date and 2500 sheep have ranged in the vicinity of Little White Rock and other springs during May, June, July, August and September of each year since 1898.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been  
1/4 cu feet cubic feet per second.  
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at a point N. 47° 30' E. 3025 ft. feet from to  
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance  
the E. 1/4 corner corner of Section 14, T. 13, R. 63 E.,  
Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at S.W. 1/4 of S.E. 1/4 Sec. 14, T. 13, N. R. 63 E. M.D.B.M.  
Describe as within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Waters from Little White Rock spring was used by J. W. Adams for watering range cattle from sometime prior to 1892 to 1898 and by The Adams-McGill Company Inc. for both cattle and sheep from 1898 to date.
