(2) The means of diversion employed is Pipe line 12 inch Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in 40 feet of wooden troughs Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun troughs were put in in 1898 or 1899 and completed

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is Owned by the U. S. Government

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Not recorded County, at Page of Book of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 125 cattle and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of Thirty days during each of the following months May, June, July, August and September

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:  
125 head of cattle from 1892 to date, and 2500 sheep have ranged in vicinity and used the waters of this and other springs during May, June, July, August and September of each year since 1898.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been  $\frac{1}{20}$  cubic feet per second.

40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at a point  $80^{\circ} 45'$  East 9700 ft feet from to the S.E. corner of Section 2, T. 13N, R. 63 E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at S.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of N.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 10, T. 13N, R. 63E. M.D.B.M.

Remarks: Water from South West Willow Creek was used by J. W. Adams for watering range cattle from 1892 to 1898 and by The Adams McGill Company Inc. for watering both sheep and cattle from 1898 to date.
