J. H. Eager, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by The Adams-McGill Company Inc. are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 10 cattle and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of thirty days during each of the following months May, June, July, August and September

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:  
10 cattle and regular headquarters for sheep camps during the months of May, June, July, August and September of each year since 1898.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been  
 $\frac{1}{40}$  cu feet per minute ~~cubic feet per second~~.  
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at a point S. 45°, East 7080 feet from to  
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance  
the S. E. corner of Section 2, T. 13, R. 63 E.,  
Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.
