and using waters of Summit and other springs during May, June, July, August and  
September of each year since 1898

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been

(10) The water is diverted from its source at a point S  $56^{\circ} 50' E$  16460 ft. to ~~feet from~~ <sup>to</sup>  
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance  
the S.E. corner of Section 1, T. 12, R. 63 E.,  
Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.
