

THE STATE OF NEVADA  
PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR  
STOCK WATERING PURPOSES



From COYOTE SPRING,  
Name of natural water course

Through pipe line

R. H. WINDER, the undersigned, being first  
duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of  
water by The MURRAY SHEEP COMPANY are full and correct to the  
best of his knowledge and belief.

R. H. Winder makes this proof in behalf of the Murray Sheep Company  
If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant  
as its President.

(1) Name of claimant MURRAY SHEEP COMPANY,  
Address Garrison, County of Millard  
State of UTAH.

(2) The means of diversion employed is dam and 400 ft. of 3/4" pipe line.  
Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in drinking pools in channel.  
Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun about 1890  
and completed about 1895.

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is  
Government land.

(6) The claimant's water right ~~was~~ (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of  
County, at Page of Book of of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was don't know  
and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of don't know days during each  
of the following months

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

Since 1911 this company has watered approximately 2000 head of sheep at this spring during certain periods of each year from April 1st to November 15th.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been

$\frac{1}{40}$  cubic feet per second.  
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at N.  $7^{\circ} 20'$  W., 2890 feet from the South  $(\frac{1}{4})$  one-quarter corner of Section 2, T. T. 5 N., R. 69 E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.  
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 5 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at SE  $\frac{1}{4}$  NW  $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 2, T. 5 N., R. 69 E., M. D. B. & M.  
Describe as within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

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
