

PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR IRRIGATION



From Baker and Lehman Creeks,

B. P. HOCKMAN, the undersigned, being first
duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by The
BAKER LIVE STOCK CO. Inc. are full and correct to the best of his
knowledge and belief.

If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(1) Name of claimant B. P. HOCKMAN
Address Baker, County of White Pine,
State of Nevada.

(2) The means of diversion employed Dan and ditch
Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The date of the survey of ditch, canal, or pipe line was Sept. 13th, 1925.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun Present ditch was made
from the original, May 1917.
and completed Spring of 1918.

(5) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as originally constructed were: Width on bottom 3 feet,
feet, width on top 4 feet, depth 2 feet, on a grade of 3 feet per thousand feet.

(6) The conduit has (has not) been enlarged.

(7) The work of enlargement of the ditch or canal was begun
and completed

(8) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as enlarged are: Width on bottom feet, width on

(19) The map provided by the State Engineer and attached hereto as a part of this proof is hereby accepted as correctly showing the ditch lines or irrigation works diverting or conveying the water claimed and the lands irrigated.

(20) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: Domestic use also.

(21) The character of the soil is sandy loam. The soil needs 2.5 acre-feet per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.
