(2) The means of diversion employed is ditch from the springs,
Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in small pools and a reservoir.
Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun 1902
and completed in 1902.

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is
Government Land.

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 600
and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 30 days during
each of the following months from April 1st to October 15th.

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

about 1000 head of sheep in 1903.
" 1500 " " 1904, and has increased each
year since that time, now watering about 2500 sheep at this spring.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been
one-fortieth, cubic feet per second.

40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at S. 16° 45' W., 5610 ft., and
S. 16° 30' W., 5640 ft., feet from
the NE. Corner, ~~xxx~~ corner of Section 35, T. 23 N., R. 66 E.
Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

(11) The works are located at S. 20° 10' W., 5600 ft. from the NE. Corner of

Company sheep until 1906, after this date, his Widow, Mrs. John
Tippet continued the use of these springs and the range surrounding
them by the Company sheep, this use has been continuous by the
Tippet Mercantile Company from that time to the present date.
The Tippet Mercantile Company is now owned by and managed
by Gus and William Sellas.
