


THE STATE OF NEVADA
PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR
STOCK WATERING PURPOSES



From Mule Spring
Name of natural water course

Through cut, and pipeline

duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by
him are full and correct to the
best of his knowledge and belief.

If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(2) The means of diversion employed is open cut dam³ of pipeline
Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in Cement trough
Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun during the year 1898
and completed during the year 1918

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is none

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 60 head
and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 30 days during
each of the following months from Jan 1st to Dec 31st of each
year

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

During the year 1899 there was from 60 to 80 head of stock watered there, and about the same number of stock watered there each year thereafter up to the year 1922. Since the year 1922 there has been times or periods when the diminished in flow & the spring in very dry year has become dry & of course only a sufficient number of stock have watered there back to use up all the water that flowed or ran from said spring.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been.....

One Sixtieth.....cubic feet per second.

40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at *in the S.W. 1/4 of S.E. 1/4 of Sec. 14, T. 4 S. R. 65 E.* feet from *Surveyed*; or at a point from *which* True Spring to nearest 2 minute distance
At the *North west* corner of Section *18*, T. *4 South*, R. *66* E. *Bears*
N 54° 05' E. 8437 feet
Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Note—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at *in the S.W. 1/4 of S.E. 1/4 of Sec 14,*
