It is the claimant's understanding and belief that this ditch was first constructed by a man named Rhoda prior to the year 1870.

The 2.5 c.f.s. of water mentioned above in (20) is an estimated average figure as more water is diverted during seasons of melting snow and rains than any other time of the year.
