

(21) Remarks: The size of this ditch at its point of diversion is 6 feet wide at the top, 5 feet wide at the bottom, and 1 foot deep. This cross section does not remain constant for very long. Due to erosion the ditch is in some places 30 feet deep and 50 feet wide at the top.


