(20) Remarks: The water from Mau Creek has irrigated the above land many years before 1900, when Mrs. Margaret Mau purchased it. James <sup>Mc</sup> Wimple ran the livestock operation at least 20 years prior to this. The deed between Annie Fenstermaker and Mrs. Margaret Mau is dated May 29, 1900 and quick claims that land described above used for irrigation to her.

The water is spread over the land by small feeder ditches designed to cover the native pasture to the fullest extent. Hay is produced by the property most years when water is adequate. Cattle are wintered on this pasture and it is very valuable to the over all operation.

The land where this water is used has an application for patent dated 1871, by James <sup>Wi</sup> Memple as recorded in the Nevada State Land Office, Carson City, Nev.


