
(20) Remarks: North Creek is not diverted from its natural channel until it reaches the deeded land. There the water is spread over the irrigated land by a series of small feeder ditches to gain maximum coverage with the water. This land is all fenced and hay is cut periodically from it. The land on which this water is used to irrigate crops has an application for patent dated 1871 by Charles Johnson as recorded in the Nevada State Land Office in Carson City, Nevada.
