(20) Remarks: This land has a patent date of June 26, 1878 and has been used as
a livestock operation since that time. There are remains of the original
stone house located just south of the point of diversion. The water flows
out of Sadler Creek and is not diverted until it reaches the deeded land.
There the water is spread over the land with small feeder ditches. In
some years hay is put up on this land, if there is enough water. Some of
the lower property is irrigated by natural seeps which is common for many
parts of Newark Valley. The pasture land is used to carry steers over to
yearlings or start heifers on.

This land has a patent date of June 29, 1878 from the State of Nevada to
Frank Betschman.


