Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision, section, township and range of public survey. If on unsurveyed

Remarks the diversion works consist of an old 3" diameter well. The well was in existence at the time the property was acquired in 1964 and it is my belief that the well was drilled in the early 1900's for stockwatering purposes.


