Remarks This spring has been used to water livestock for over 100 years  
It is an important source of water for the operation of the ranch.  
The location is such that the Pinto Creek grazing allotment in the  
Diamond Mountains can be more fully utilized from this water source.  
The spring is cleaned out from time to time by the ranch foreman in  
order to maintain the flow.

Remarks...The allotments commensurate property has patent dates from as early as 1876. Peter M. Keisch patented part of the Deeded land on 3/20/1876, as did Daniel A. High on 4/22/1879, Fracisco Sagarini on 2/8/1890 and James Savery on 12/22/1888. This ranch has been a livestock operation running both cattle and sheep on this range since it was patented by the early settlers.

The undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by UNITED DRESSED BEEF, INC. are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.


