


THE STATE OF NEVADA
PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR IRRIGATION



From Cold Springs Creek
Name of natural water source

Through Cold Springs Ditch
Name of ditch, flume, or pipe line

Roy W. Stoddard, the undersigned, being first

duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by Williams Estate Company, a corporation are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

Affiant makes this proof on behalf of claimant and is the duly authorized and appointed Attorney for the Williams Estate Company, a corporation.

(1) Name of claimant Williams Estate Company

(2) The means of diversion employed Dams and ditches
Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The date of the survey of ditch, canal, or pipe line was before 1903.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun before 1903
and completed before 1903.

(5) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as originally constructed were: Width on bottom 1 to 2 feet, width on top 3 to 5 feet, depth 1 to 2 feet, on a grade of 1 to 100 feet per thousand feet.

(6) The conduit has (has not) been enlarged, except by erosion
NOTE—If enlargement or extension of ditch was made, supply information under (7) and (8)

(7) The work of enlargement of the ditch or canal was begun and completed.

(8) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as enlarged are: Width on bottom feet, width on top feet, depth feet, on a grade of feet per thousand feet.

(9) The claimant is (is not) an owner in the above-described conduit.

(10) The nature of the title to the land for which the water right is claimed is U. S. patent and vacant government land.

(11) Crops of alfalfa, grass, potatoes and garden truck have been grown upon the land irrigated.

(12) The water has been used for irrigation from March 1 to October 15 of each year.

(13) The water was first used for irrigation by claimant or its grantors in the year 1903 before when 23.44 acres were irrigated in the SW 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. N 2 of SE 1/4 E. R. SE 1/4 of NW 1/4 and NE 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 20, T. 18. N., R. 37 E., M. D. B. & M.

(15) The maximum acreage irrigated in any year was 23.44 acres.

(16) The water claimed has (has not) been used for irrigation each and every year since the right was initiated.
Strike out one not wanted

(17) The years during which no water was used for irrigation or during which the full water right was not used were 1915, 1918, and 1920 to 1926, inclusive. Water supply short due to dry years but entire flow of stream used.
If water was not used, or used in reduced quantity at any time, full information as to causes and duration of non-use should be given, appending a sheet if necessary

(18) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of County, said record being at page..... of Book..... of and being a claim for..... of water for the irrigation of.....

NOTE—Failure to record in the county in no way invalidates a water right, but if ditch or right was so recorded, supply full information under (19)

(19) The map provided by the State Engineer and attached hereto as a part of this proof is hereby accepted as correctly showing the ditch lines or irrigation works diverting or conveying the water claimed and the lands irrigated.

(20) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: ~~domestic use and watering stock throughout the year.~~

(21) The character of the soil is loam (Sandy, gravelly, loam) The soil needs 4 1/2 acre-feet per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of 1.0 cubic feet of water per average second, during the irrigation season of 7 1/2 months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.

(22) Remarks: The water supply from the source is extremely variable ranging from 1 to 4 second feet in March and April but dropping to as low as 0.25 second foot by July 1 and even lower later in the season. It is therefore necessary to use all available water early in order to obtain the required total supply.

The water from Rock Creek is commingled with the water from Pony and Cold Springs Creek making it practically impossible to segregate the area irrigated from each source. It is estimated, however, that the water supply from each source is sufficient to take care of one third of the area under cultivation.
