


THE STATE OF NEVADA  
PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR IRRIGATION



From War Canyon Creek  
Name of natural water source

Through War Canyon Ditch  
Name of ditch, flume, or pipe line

Roy W. Stoddard, the undersigned, being first

duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by Williams Estate Company, a corporation are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

Affiant makes this proof on behalf of claimant and is the duly authorized and appointed Attorney for the Williams Estate Company, a corporation.

(1) Name of claimant Williams Estate Company  
Address Fallon, County of Churchill  
State of Nevada

(2) The means of diversion employed Dams, ditches and pipeline  
Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The date of the survey of ditch, canal, or pipe line was Unknown

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun 1866  
and completed

(5) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as originally constructed were: Width on bottom 1 to 3 feet, width on top 3 to 6 feet, depth 1 to 4 feet, on a grade of 3 to 40 feet per thousand feet.

(6) The conduit has (has not) been enlarged. except by erosion in places.  
NOTE—If enlargement or extension of ditch was made, supply information under (7) and (8)

(7) The work of enlargement of the ditch or canal was begun and completed

(8) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as enlarged are: Width on bottom feet, width on top feet, depth feet, on a grade of feet per thousand feet.

(9) The claimant is (is not) an owner in the above-described conduit.

(10) The nature of the title to the land for which the water right is claimed is State patent and vacant government land

(11) Crops of alfalfa, grain, potatoes, fruit and garden truck have been grown upon the land irrigated.

(12) The water has been used for irrigation from March 1 to October 15 of each year.

(13) The water was first used for irrigation by claimant or its grantors in the year 1866 when 48.45 acres were irrigated in the SE 1/4 of NW 1/4; S 1/2 of Sec. NE 1/4 of Sec. 4 E., R. E. and N 1/2 of SW 1/4; SW 1/4 of NW 1/4; and SE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 3, T. 19 N., R. 37 E., M. D. B. & M., and NE 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Sec. 5, T. 19 N., R. 37 E., M. D. B. & M.

(14) The additional number of acres first irrigated in subsequent years was as follows:

(15) The maximum acreage irrigated in any year was 48.45 acres.

(16) The water claimed has (has not) been used for irrigation each and every year since the right was initiated. Strike out one not wanted

(17) The years during which no water was used for irrigation or during which the full water right was not used were 1920 to 1926, inclusive, Water short due to dry years. If water was not used, or used in reduced quantity at any time, full information as to causes and duration of non-use should be given, appending a sheet if necessary

(18) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Churchill County, said record being at page 37 of Book 2 of Miscellaneous, and being a claim for All water in Clan Alpine of water for the irrigation of Clan Alpine Barley Ranches acres of land in the following legal subdivisions: Not shown

NOTE—Failure to record in the county in no way invalidates a water right, but if ditch or right was so recorded, supply full information under (19)

(19) The map provided by ~~the State Engineer~~ and attached hereto as a part of this proof is hereby accepted as correctly showing the ditch lines or irrigation works diverting or conveying the water claimed and the lands irrigated.

(20) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: ~~Domestic use and watering stock throughout the year~~

(21) The character of the soil is gravelly loam The soil needs 4 1/2 acre-feet  
(Sandy, gravelly, loam)  
per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of 1.0 cubic feet of water per average second, during the irrigation season of 7 1/2 months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.

(22) Remarks: Owing to the variable supply, normally from 2 to 5  
second feet early in the season, but dwindling to 1/2 second  
foot or less in June, it is necessary to use a much larger flow  
early in the season.
