PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES

J. H. Eger, Manager for the Adams-McGill Co., Inc., the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by The Adams-McGill Company, Inc. are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

(1) Name of claimant The Adams-McGill Company Address Ely County of White Pine State of Nevada

(2) The means of diversion employed is natural channel Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 500 cattle and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 210 days during each of the following months April, May, June, July, August, September, October November and 1887

(8)-The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

During May, June, July, August, September, October and November of each year from 1887 to 1897 inclusive, J. W. Adams used water for 500 or more range cattle. From 1898 to 1910 inclusive Adams & McGill, a partnership, watered from 100 to 500 cattle and from 5000 to 10000 sheep. The Adams-McGill Company Inc. have used the water for 500 or more cattle and 5000 to 10000 sheep since 1911.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been 1/20 cubic feet per second.

40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at N 51 degrees 50 minutes E 22230 feet feet from the S.W corner of Section 25, T. 14 N., R. 64 E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.
