

PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES



From Willow Spring
Through Willow Spring Watering Place
Edwin Lytle, the undersigned, being first

duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by him are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(2) The means of diversion employed is an open cut across the canyon
Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in a series of three Earth Dams
Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun about the year 1900
and completed at the same time

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is none

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was
and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of days during each
of the following months the entire year

Claimant has watered approximately 200 head of stock at this Spring continually since he developed the water there, about 1900
about 180 head of which were cattle and the rest horses

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

about 200 head each year, of which about 180 were cattle and the rest are horses

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been

3 gallons per minute ~~cubic feet per second~~
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at South $13^{\circ} 16'$ East 2650 feet from
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance
the South Quarter corner of Section 13, T. 2 N., R. 68 E E.,
Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at at the Spring
Describe as within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: At the spring a cut has been run across the wash to bring the water to the surface and three dams have been placed across the wash at intervals of about 100 feet. These dams are made of small cedars and earth about ten feet across the top and three feet at the bottom and from two to three feet high at the center.
