

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

200 cattle watered here from prior to 1892 to 1898 and 100 cattle and 2500 sheep have watered from this and other springs while ranging in this vicinity during the months of April, May, June, July, August and September of each year since 1898.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been $\frac{1}{4}$ cubic feet per second.

(10) The water is diverted from its source at a point $N 20$ degrees $E 8330$ feet feet from
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance
the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 16, T. 10 N., R. 63 E.,
Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located in N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 9, T 10N, R 63E.

Remarks: J. W. Adams used the waters of this and other springs in vicinity to water cattle from prior to 1892 to 1898. From 1898 to date the Adams-McGill ~~xxxxxxx~~ (successors to J. W. Adams) used the water for both cattle and sheep and The Adams-McGill Company Inc. have used them continuously since.
