duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by
himself are full and correct to the
best of his knowledge and belief.

If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(1) Name of claimant A.C. Florio

(2) The means of diversion employed is Dam & pipe line.
Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in Trough & dam.
Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun About August 1920
and completed in August 1920.

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is Occupation
and use of land on public domain.

(6) The claimant's water right was (was ~~not~~) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of
Eureka County, at Page 207 of Book 18 of Deeds

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 2000
and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 10 days during
Jan, Feb, March, April, May, June, July, August, Sept, Oct,
Nov. & Dec.

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

8000 head of sheep, 10 horses, 10 burrows, 200 head of cattle.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been:

.10 cubic feet per second.
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at $S. 38^{\circ}55'E 2337$ feet from
the $N. W.$ corner of Section 17 , T $18N$, R $54 E$.
Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Note—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at $S. E. \frac{1}{4}$ of $NW \frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 17, T. 18N, R. 54E
M.P.B. & M. Describe as within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: The Evans Spring has been used since 1870 and title passed along from the original owner to subsequent owners to Mr. A. S. Florio. Said spring was purchased by A. S. Florio from Mrs. Francis Evans in year 1915 and he has paid taxes on it since that date. All present improvements at spring were made by A. S. Florio. At time of purchase of spring by Florio a house and fence stood near property which were included in the purchase. These were removed by him without objection from other parties.
