PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES

From LOWER PARISH SPRING. Name of natural water course

Through LOWER PARISH SPRING. Name of ditch, pipe line, etc.

James C. Riordan, the undersigned, being first

duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by him are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(1) Name of claimant James C. Riordan, Address Sunnyside, County of Nye, State of Nevada.

(2) The means of diversion employed is pipe line and wooden troughs. Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in wooden troughs. Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun in 1886, and completed 1919.

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is unsurveyed public land.

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of County, at Page of Book of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 25 head cattle and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 365 days during each of the following months all months of the year.

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

From the year 1885, the number of cattle watered at said spring gradually increased until in the year 1903, and ever since that time, approximately 200 head of cattle have been ~~at~~ watered at this spring;

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been

0.01 cubic feet per second.

40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at a point which is N. 84° 30' West, 12,640 feet from

True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance

the Southwest corner of Section 6, T. 7 N., R. 60 E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, and approximately in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 3, in said township and range, if surveyed.

Note: Information under this clause invariably to be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at the point described in Answer 10.

Describe as within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: M.L. Riordan, the father of this applicant, first used this spring in 1885, and continued to use the same until the time of his death in 1908; since that time it has been used by this applicant who purchased the estate of his father. Up to the year 1919, the spring was kept cleaned out and reservoir maintained sufficient to use all the water, and in that year the spring was cleaned out, covered over and a pipe line 40 feet in length connected with the spring and running to wooden troughs 34 feet in length, 12 inches wide and 10 inches deep.

Remarks: All the real estate, personal property, range and water rights were conveyed by the heirs of the applicant's father to this applicant in 1909, and this deed is of record in the office of the County Recorder of Nye County, Nevada; the range and water rights are therein described generally and not specifically.
