PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES

From MOORMAN SPRING CHANNEL.

Name of natural water course

James C. Riordan, the undersigned, being first

duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by him are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(1) Name of claimant James C. Riordan,

State of Nevada.

(2) The means of diversion employed is Moorman Spring Channel.

Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in not impounded.

Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun No works constructed. and completed.

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is fee simple.

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 300 cattle and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 275 days during each of the following months September to June.

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

In the year 1893, approximately 300 head of cattle were watered at this channel and this increased until in 1903, approximately 1200 head of cattle were being watered at this channel, and continuously from the time until 1923 the same number were watered, and since that time the claimant has been watering 500 50 600 head of cattle each year there and from 1200 to 1800 head of sheep; the use of the water has been continuous.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been

0.25 cubic feet per second.
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at not diverted but used in ~~XXXXXX~~
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance
the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ~~XXXXXX~~ of Section 32, T. 9 N., R. 61 E.,
Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

(11) The works are located at SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 32, Tp. 9 N. 61 E. M.D.M.

Remarks: This water is used from the natural channel which is kept cleaned and in good condition at all times by the claimant.

Claimant's father, M. L. Riordan, first used the water for stock watering purposes in the year 1893, and continued to use the same until his death in 1908; thereafter it has been used by the claimant who purchased the real estate and water rights from the heirs of his said father, and the deed therefor is recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Nye County, Nevada. The water in this channel runs practically the full length of the quarter section above described and the said quarter section is owned by the claimant.


