PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR IRRIGATION

James C. Riordan, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by him are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(1) Name of claimant James C. Riordan,
Address Sunnyside, County of Nye,
State of Nevada.

(2) The means of diversion employed Dam, ditches and laterals.
Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The date of the survey of ditch, canal, or pipe line was December 12, 1926.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun 1902,
and completed in the year 1902.

(5) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as originally constructed were: Width on bottom 2 feet, width on top 4 feet, depth 2 feet, on a grade of 5 feet per thousand feet.

(6) The conduit has (has not) been enlarged.
NOTE—If enlargement or extension of ditch was made, supply information under (7) and (8)

(7) The work of enlargement of the ditch or canal was begun Nil
and completed

(8) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as enlarged are: Width on bottom: feet, width on top: feet, depth: feet, on a grade of: feet per thousand feet.

(9) The claimant is (is not) an owner in the above-described conduit.
Claimant is the sole owner.
If claimant is an owner in the conduit, state interest held on this line

(10) The nature of the title to the land for which the water right is claimed is fee simple.

(11) Crops of pasture, alfalfa, grain and potatoes, have been grown upon the land irrigated.

(12) The water has been used for irrigation from April 1st to December 1st, of each year.

(13) The water was first used for irrigation by claimant or his grantors in the year 1902 when 6.1 acres were irrigated in the NE 1/4 of SD 32 of Sec. 32, T. 9 N., R. 61 E., M. D. M.

(19) The map provided by the State Engineer and attached hereto as a part of this proof is hereby accepted as correctly showing the ditch lines or irrigation works diverting or conveying the water claimed and the lands irrigated.

(20) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: For domestic use when cultivating and planting and harvesting the crops grown upon the said land.

(21) The character of the soil is sandy loam, The soil needs 3 acre-feet
(Sandy, gravelly, loam)
per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of 1 cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of 8 months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.

(22) Remarks: This water was first used by the claimant's father, M.L. Riordan from the year 1902 to the time of his death in 1908; after the death of the claimant's father, the claimant purchased the land and water right from his father's heirs and it has been used by this claimant continuously ever since. The deed of the land is recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Nye County, Nevada.
