(21) The character of the soil is Gravelly loam The soil needs _____ acre-feet per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of about one cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of 12 months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.

(22) Remarks: There are no other users of water from this creek. All of the normal flow of the stream has been used by claimant and predecessors in interest since the year specified.
The water from Petersen Creek is combined with the water from Park Creek and Schoonhovee Creek and used on the above described lands


