William Sellas are full and correct to the
best of his knowledge and belief.

(2) The means of diversion employed is small dams across channel to form
drinking pools. Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in small reservoirs
Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun in the year 1897
and completed same year

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is
Government land.

(6) The claimant's water right ~~was~~ (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 1500
and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 30 days during
each of the following months May, June, July, August, September & October

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

From 1500 to 2500 head of sheep have been watered here and in this vicinity by the claimant or his predecessors in interest each and every year since the year 1897.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been

one-fortieth cubic feet per second.

40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at N. 60° E., 1200 feet from

the South $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 4, T. 25N., R. 67 E. Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at the springs in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 4, T. 25 N., R. 67 E.

Remarks: In the year 1879 William McCurdy and James Hutton started using this range and water, they ran 1500 head of sheep on this range, watering them at these springs during the summer months, they continuously used the range and water from that time until the year 1897 when they sold their stock, range and water rights to John Chapman and Frank McCurdy who continued the use of the range and water, developing more water and running about 2000 head of sheep thereon during the summer months, Chapman and McCurdy later sold their stock, range and water rights to F. A. Raabe who continued the use as above stated and in July 1927, Raabe sold his range, Chin Creek ranch, irrigation and all stockwatering rights to the deponent, William Sellas, who ran 2500 head of sheep on this range during the summer of 1927.

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
