(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been

(10) The water is diverted from its source at S. 83° 05' E. 4760 ft feet from
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance

the NW corner of Section 22, T. 44 N., R. 23 E.

Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at point of diversion

Remarks: This water was first developed and used by the Pacific Livestock Company about 1880, when they first acquired the land, which has been purchased from KK it by the Thousand Creek L.S. Co. The stream bed is sandy, amount of water limited and it is impossible to convey the water acut of the bed of the stream. Holes were dug for the purpose of getting water for cattle and camp purposes and cleaned out every few years. This watering place is used each and every year for the holding of cattle while working them in the spring and fall of each year and two corrals were here but were burned down 4 years ago.
