(21) The character of the soil is *Sandy Loam* (Sandy, gravelly, loam) The soil needs acre-feet per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of *1* cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of *4* months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.

(22) Remarks: *The water from this source has been used continuously by claimant when available for irrigation of the areas designated, except during the past two years, when water was not available due to the fact that Pat Walsh, owner of adjoining property, built a ditch around to the north of claimant's property, thereby carrying the entire flow of Cottonwood Creek to Reese River, and preventing claimant from using said waters.*
