PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR IRRIGATION

From Crum Creek (Crum and Wilson Creeks) Name of natural water source

Through ditch Name of ditch, flume, or pipe line

Martin Filippini, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by Martin Filippini and Ed Filippini, Co-partners, are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

Martin Filippini makes this proof for Martin Filippini and Ed Filippini, Co-partners. If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(1) Name of claimant s Martin Filippini and Ed Filippini Address Beowawe County of Eureka State of Nevada

(2) The means of diversion employed dam and ditch. Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The date of the survey of ditch, canal, or pipe line was ditch constructed without services of surveyor.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun prior to Spring of 1863, and completed 1870.

(5) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as originally constructed were: Width on bottom three feet, width on top ten feet, depth three feet, on a grade of two feet per thousand feet.

(6) The conduit has (has not) been enlarged but location changed and new ditch built. NOTE-If enlargement or extension of ditch was made, supply information under (7) and (8)

(7) The work of enlargement of the ditch or canal was begun in Spring of 1908, and completed in Spring of 1908.

(8) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as enlarged are: Width on bottom three feet, width on top six feet, depth four feet, on a grade of 2 1/2 feet per thousand feet.

(9) The claimant is (is not) an owner in the above-described conduit. Conduit owned entirely by Martin Filippini and Ed Filippini. If claimant is an owner in the conduit, state interest held on this line

(10) The nature of the title to the land for which the water right is claimed is fee simple.

(11) Crops of hay have been grown upon the land irrigated.

(12) The water has been used for irrigation from March 1st to September 1st, of each year. Day of month Day of month

(Sandy, gravelly, loam)
per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of one cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of six months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.
