 duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by  
Hankings-Bellinger Co. and its predecessors are full and correct to the best of his  
 knowledge and belief.

(1) Name of claimant Hankings-Bellinger Co., a corporation

 State of Nevada

(2) The means of diversion employed ditches leading to reservoir and onto land to be irrigated.  
Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The date of the survey of ditch, canal, or pipe line was 12/26/27 (for purpose of map)

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun 1884  
 and completed 1884

(5) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as originally constructed were: Width on bottom 16"  
~~feet~~ width on top two feet, depth one feet, on a grade of -- feet per thousand feet.

(6) The conduit has (has not) been enlarged.

(7) The work of enlargement of the ditch or canal was begun

 when 26.95 acres were irrigated in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 26  
T. 34 N., R. 58 E., M. D. B. & M., Elko Co., Nevada.



(19) The map provided by the State Engineer and attached hereto as a part of this proof is hereby accepted as correctly showing the ditch lines or irrigation works diverting or conveying the water claimed and the lands irrigated.

(20) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: Watering of 125 head of horses and cattle during each month of the year, also for other domestic purposes.

(21) The character of the soil is loam (Sandy, gravelly, loam) The soil needs three acre-feet per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of five cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of 5 months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.


